**General information** - Vendors are required to remain open from 10:00am to 4:00pm on Saturday, August 24<sup>th</sup>. Set-up time is from 12pm to 8pm on Friday, August 23<sup>rd</sup> or 8:00 am to 9:45 am on Saturday August 25th.

Vendors are responsible to remove any garbage when disassembling their booth.
